Troops of Mona monkey, Green emerald snake, birds, crabs, Beetles, butterfly, skink, Dragonfly, Monitor lizards and footprint of Sitatunga were sighted in the park.

Coastal erosion & Encroachment: monitoring of coastal erosion is ongoing, as observation shows that
siltation and deposition of debris along the shoreline still persist. Follow up monitoring of the three
points that were ear-marked for measurement changed; coastal area measurement from Ship Wreck
is 150meters away from the Sea, from Hippo creek its 110meters away from the Sea, while from
Almond Tree is 95meters respectively.
